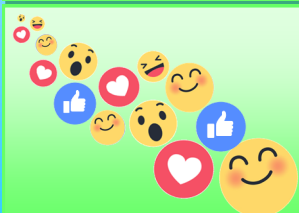


During the 3rd Quarter the staff will have the option to wear blue jeans on the last Friday & Saturday of the month to help raise & donate money & school supplies to our local schools.

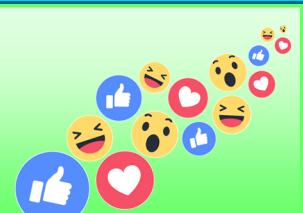

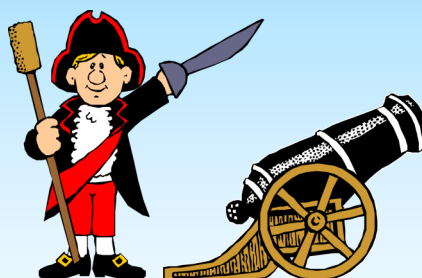
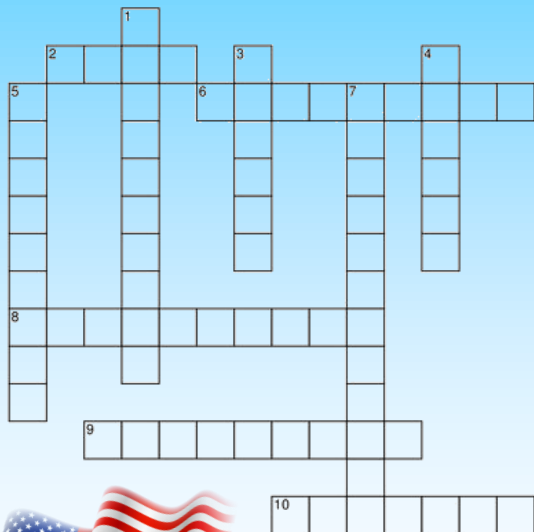
